Activity 5:

Let's build a bonfire!

This craft is quite simple. Want to give it a try?

Before you start building the bonfire, here are some **examples** to help you choose the one you like best:

As you can see in the examples, a bonfire can be built in different ways. We've chosen one similar to the first image.

Next, we'll tell you how to do it:

Materials:

- Two squares of cardboard, of the size you want the bonfire to be.
- A round piece of cardboard for the base.
- A **pencil** and an **eraser**, to draw the outline.
- Paint or markers, to colour!
- Crepe paper of any colour you want (or newspaper!)

Instructions:



Cut the two equal pieces of cardboard in the shape of a flame and paint them.



Cut out the round base and decorate it, gluing on the paper (which you can also paint).



Make a cut in each flame, from the top to the centre, put the flames together and glue them to the base!

Our fire pit is ready!
